ADVANCED PLACEMENT CREDIT HOURS

Virginia Tech ranks among the nation's top universities for the number of freshmen enrolling with AP credit. Students admitted to Virginia Tech who merit advanced placement through Advanced Placement Examinations may obtain up to 38 semester hours of credit. Advanced placement credits are shown as AP credit on the student's grade report and are in-

cluded as hours passed toward a degree. **Test results must be sent directly to the Office of the University Registrar (school code 5859) from the testing service.** The following chart shows the subject area exams for which Virginia Tech currently awards AP credit. The number of semester credit hours awarded depends on the exam score, as shown. These
